We believe that an open line of communication between the dance teacher and the parents is essential to a successful dance experience. Our teachers will email the class periodically to update the parents on the progress of the class and any other pertinent class information. The studio will also email everyone regularly with all studio news, recital information, and information regarding new programs, special events, and contests/special offers. Studio Policies

- We follow the School District with vacations and inclement weather closings; However we do not follow the <u>in-service days- there will be dance class on those days.</u>
- There is no discount or refund for missed classes, unless for medical.
- All studio accounts have one primary account holder. This is the account holder that registers and signs the registration form. This account holder will be the one considered financially responsible for the account.

- Students should wait until the teacher is present before entering the classroom, unless
 directed otherwise. All students should exit the classroom at the end of class. Younger
 students whose parents have not yet arrived for pickup should wait with one of our
 office staff members.
- Any student with an overdue balance of more than 90 days will not be allowed into class until payment in full is received or payment arrangements have been made.
- Costume orders can only be picked up once the account is paid in full with no balance remaining.

Keep Informed Through E-Mail, Texts, Social Media

A majority of the information we send you will be sent through our email mailing list. Email helps us efficiently keep everyone up to date on news and events at the VDC. We chose email to cut back on paper and envelope usage and to help the planet! Please make sure we have your correct email address on file. We also use text if there are quick reminders, or cancellations due to weather, or a sick teacher. The Facebook page is used as well. If you do not receive a certain email, all of our emails are available within your portal. Just click on the messages tab.

Online Account Portal

The VDC is proud to offer an online solution for parents and account holders to access all of their account information online. This service allows users to process payments for charges, enter and modify contact information, and register for select classes from the comfort of their home - 24 hours a day.

If you've already logged in to our customer portal, just visit our website, click the "Parent Portal" tab. If you don't remember your password, you can have your password emailed to you by clicking "Forgot Password?"

Tuition and Payments

- Registration Fee \$35 (non-refundable) (\$10 each additional family member, or additional class thereafter)
- The studio calendar and tuition rate is designed to give 30 classes over a Seven-month period from (August for Company) October to May; otherwise, preschool rates of \$45, single class rates of \$50-\$55 per hour long class will apply, \$65 for 1.5+.
- All Lessons are paid for in advance, due the 1st of each month. You will not receive a bill
 prior to the due date of tuition, unless you request this. Late notices will be emailed to
 all past due accounts. There will be a \$5 added charge for any account not paid in full by
 the 10th. This charge will continue to be added each month it remains late.
- There will be no refunds or deductions for lessons missed. This includes long holidays.

- <u>Costumes are a requirement for our dance classes</u>- these are purchased at the end of January/February and you'll see a charge for these. Most costumes are between \$50.00 and \$100.00.
- Recital Fee \$55 (non-refundable) (\$10 each additional family member)
- We accept Cash, Check, Visa, or MasterCard. There will be a \$25 returned check charge for all checks returned from the bank.

Dance Shoes and Dancewear

We have a new site called Nimbly- this is our online store. When you need to create an account, all orders will be shipped to the studio. www.shopnimbly.com/vdc

Ballet shoes should be worn snug, with ties tucked in at all times. Ballet is the only class that requires a pink leotard and pink tights, (skirts are optional). All other classes require regular dance attire and can be worn in any color. Hair should be up and away from the face. A Ballet bun is preferred for Ballet classes. Girl's tap shoes must be secured with elastic or tap shoe ties. Please discard ribbons. No street clothes, necklaces, bracelets, & large earrings should be brought or worn to class.

Costumes

All dance classes will have 1 or more costumes for our recital in May. Dance costumes will be ordered after the holiday break, by February. The estimated cost for costumes is between \$50-\$100, we try to keep this cost as low as possible. Your account will be billed when they are ordered, and must be paid in full before receiving your costume. There will be no refunds for costumes.

Annual Recital Production

Our Annual Dance Recital is part of the student's dance education. Our recital is May 18, 2023 and each student will be required to attend classes regularly, attend rehearsals associated with the recital, and pay for any costume(s) needed for their number. There is an annual recital fee of \$55 per student.
